Obama signs technology access bill

Blind and deaf people will be able to more easily use smart phones, the Internet and other technologies that are staples of life and work under a bill signed into law this month. In the East Room of the White House, President Barack Obama portrayed the occasion as another step in guaranteeing equal access, opportunity and respect for all Americans. The new law "will make it easier for people who are deaf, blind or live with a visual impairment to do what many of us take for granted," he said, from navigating a TV or DVD menu to sending an e-mail on a smart phone.
